Code of Conduct

Maryhill Football Club (MFC) has a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. MFC will encourage players, officials, and spectators on the appropriate standards of etiquette and behaviour that are required of them to ensure football can be enjoyed by everyone in a safe and positive environment.

On and off the field, MFC players, officials and spectators should: -

- a. Show respect to others involved in the game, including match officials, players, coaches, managers, media, and spectators.
- b. Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game.
- c. Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour.
- d. Never engage in public criticism of match officials.
- e. Never engage in public criticism of the Scottish Football Association, WoSFL, or any other football bodies, or of its officials or member clubs.
- f. Never engage in or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour
- g. Never engage in or tolerate any form of bullying.
- h. Report any child protection issues to our Child Wellbeing and Protection Officer
